What is the SQUASH Cancer Tournament?

Join the Squash community of the Upper Valley for this new and exciting event celebrating its second year! The Squash Cancer Tournament features:

- a minimum of 3 squash matches per participant
- an exhibition game featuring US Squash players and Dartmouth Squash players
- the opportunity to go head-to-head with the same US Squash players in "Play with a Pro!"

Event location: The Berry Center, situated on the Dartmouth College Campus.

No experience? No problem! All skill levels are welcome at this event. Participants will play a minimum of three individual matches in which every point counts.

Registrants are welcome to start a team, join an existing team, or register as an individual. Each person is required to meet their minimum fundraising commitment: \$100 for adults, \$50 for students.

Proceeds from this fundraiser benefit cancer research and patient supportive services at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Norris Cotton Cancer Center.

The projects funded with the help of funds from Friends' events affect patient treatment around the world as well as in the Upper Valley, through world-class research and innovative clinical trials.


