PRESENTATION FORMAT AND TIME GUIDELINES

Due to the number of speakers and project areas that will be presented, and to be fair to everyone involved we will adhere to a <u>very strict</u> time schedule.

- Each investigator presenting shall use no more than 1 title slide and 10 presentation slides (described below)
- Each investigator will be allowed 8–10 minutes to present

TITLE SLIDE

List the investigator's

- Name
- Department/Section/Center
- Title
- DCC research appt
- DCC shared resources used
- Specialty training
- Current areas of expertise

PRESENTATION SLIDES 1-8

- List the major research approaches used (type(s) of study or assay, e.g. IGRT-based, animal models, liposomes, signaling, computer imaging algorithm, outcome modeling, genomics/proteomics, clinical trial, drug/XRT study, etc.)
- For each of the approaches, the project areas to which they are applied should be listed and very briefly described

PRESENTATION SLIDE 9

- For each project discussed above there should be a statement of the title, the funding source, the current project period and the total and current funding
- The collaborating investigators and institutional/department/center affiliations should be listed

PRESENTATION SLIDE 10

Future directions (grants applied for) and listing of manuscripts from your group on this research topic.
